

The new rules for Garbage and Recycling Rules are effective Friday, June 23, 2023 and are as follows.

We ask that shareholders recycle ONLY IF they can follow these rules. If you do not wish to follow these rules, please deposit your recyclables (other than cardboard) in the general waste bins.

For Shareholders who do NOT wish to recycle their garbage:

1. Shareholders must place all garbage and recyclables, except for corrugated cardboard, in a securely tied plastic bag and deposit the bag in any of the garbage stations on Harbor or Atlantic Walks except for the single recyclables station on Harbor Walk near the entrance walk to the Site Office.
2. All corrugated cardboard must be broken down and tied together and brought to the designated area near the Site Office off Harbor Walk.

For shareholders who wish to recycle their garbage:

1. Garbage is defined as all waste except for recyclables. In addition to traditionally considered normal garbage, the following are included: glass, plastic other than category 1 and category 2, styrofoam, packing material, plasticized cardboard (milk and juice cartons), pizza boxes with food and oil remnants, unwashed plastic and metal cans, egg cartons.
2. Recyclables is defined as category 1 and category 2 plastic, metal cans. These must be rinsed free of all food prior to disposal. Newspaper, magazines, corrugated cardboard are also recyclables.
3. Shareholders must place all regular garbage in a securely tied plastic bag and deposit the bag in any of the garbage stations on Harbor or Atlantic Walks except for the single recyclable station on Harbor Walk near the entrance walk to the office.
4. All corrugated cardboard must be broken down and tied together and brought to the designated area near the Site Office off Harbor Walk
5. Shareholders must place all clean plastic and metal recyclable in a securely tied plastic bag and deposit the bag in the designated section of recyclable station adjacent to the walkway leading to the Site Office. NOTE: Recyclables contaminated with food will not be collected by the garbage collector.
6. Shareholders must bundle and tie together all newspapers and magazines and deposit them in the designated section of the recyclables station adjacent to the walkway leading to the Site Office.

NOTES:

1. No loose regular garbage, plastic, metal cans, or glass may be discarded in any of the garbage stations.
2. Shareholders are responsible for informing their guests and their renters of these guidelines. It is recommended shareholders hang the attached document in their unit's kitchen area.
3. Landscaping products (dirt, plants, twigs, etc) are NOT considered garbage and may NOT be put in the garbage stations.
4. It is recommended that you hang a copy of the new rules (see attachment) near your apartment's garbage container for easy reference.
